

Second Arab Land Conference

22 - 24 February 2021 Cairo, Egypt

The Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt is pleased to host the Second Arab Land Conference that will be organized under the patronage of the Egyptian Minister of Housing, Utilities and Urban Communities. The Conference is organized by the Housing and Building National Research Centre represented by the Urban Training and Studies Institute in partnership with UN-Habitat, the Global Land Tool Network (GLTN), the World Bank, the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), the Dubai Land Department, and the Network of Excellence of Land Governance in Africa (NELGA).

The Conference will focus on the priorities of the Arab Land Initiative: promote collaboration and coordination; develop and share knowledge; develop capacities of individuals and organizations; and support the implementation of land-related programmes and interventions. The Conference will be a platform to discuss countries experiences, present new research, foster high level commitment to improve land management, and develop the capacities of land stakeholders from the region.
